Who is Richard Bingold ?

Richard Bingold, Catholic lay evangelist, has travelled much from his home in Vermont, America, with his Rosary fashioned out of the stones of Apparition Hill, Medjugorje. The formation of the Rosary correlates to Our Lady's call to conversion. Just like the stones needed grinding, so too the pilgrim must become like clay in the Potter's Hand pliable to His touch, ready to be formed according to His plan. The centre stone of the Rosary, a large stone that resembles a human's heart exuded the smell of roses when it was made. Richard was overwhelmed and then gave his Fiat to Our Lady. Richard took the Rosary back to Medjugorje once it was completed where Vicka, one of the visionaries presented it to Our Lady. It was approved as a pilgrim Rosary to travel the world for all to see and touch. Richard travels with the permission of two Bishops from the USA, who have approved his ministry.

Many thousands of people have been touched and healed through Our Lady's intervention. In the last ten years Richard has prayed over some 90000 people with the Pilgrim Rosary. Richard, when he travels, shares his testimony of his conversion, which describes his alcoholism, the effects of it on his five children and his conversion to the person he is today.
